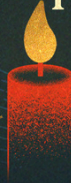

Assist with check-ins and create a warm, friendly first impression for families. You'll play a key role in ensuring families feel at ease and valued from the moment they arrive.

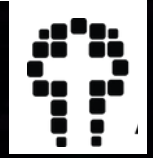


## WEEKDAY VOLUNTEER
